There are plans for the BBC to move all its production facilities either to Broadcasting House or to the new BBC Centre in Salford, so time is running out to see Television Centre with the BBC still in residence.

As it's a working building no two tours are alike, but we're likely to see studios, the BBC News centre, dressing-rooms and the BBC's interactive studio. The tour will start at 3.30pm (with some starting at 3.45pm if attendance is strong) and last between 90 minutes and two hours, and will be followed by supper on own account nearby.
